- Attachment-based Development relationships and co-regulation first
- Polyvagal-informed Practice calm nervous systems invite learning

## 6. Subjects & Methods

#### History & Geography

Living narratives, map work, dramatic play

#### Natural History & Nature Study

Observation, journaling, indoor soil trays, weekly "Nature Show & Tell"

#### Poetry & Recitation

Classics that nurture language and memory

#### Composer & Picture Study

One composer/artist per term; narration & discussion

#### **Handicrafts**

Clay, sewing, weaving, origami

#### Music & Folk Songs + Spanish

Singing for ear training and cultural awareness

#### Free Play & Community

Unstructured play and social growth



#### 7. Policies & Procedures

#### Attendance & Punctuality

Drop-off 8:50–9:05 am. Pick-up 1:55–2:05 pm. Please text if running late.

#### Illness

Children must be fever-free for 24 hrs and symptom-free of stomach bugs for 48 hrs before returning.

#### **Behaviour & Emotional Support**

We guide through connection, not sticker charts or time-outs. Teachers co-regulate and support emotional processing.

#### Younger Siblings

Ages 4–5 may enroll with an older sibling if readiness criteria are met.

Weekly recap email plus announcements in our private Facebook group.
